Point South is strategically located in Jasper County, at the intersection of I-95 and U.S. 17 at Exit 33, in the heart of the booming South Carolina Lowcountry.

Point South is currently a convenient and affordable tourist stop offering over 300 hotel rooms, six restaurants, two campgrounds, and three fuel stops, plus specialty and convenience stores. The location offers easy access to world class tourist destinations, including Beaufort (24 miles), Hilton Head (50 miles), Savannah (60 miles), Charleston (65 miles), Myrtle Beach (139 miles), and Orlando (358 miles). With Orlando and many other vacation destinations less than eight hours away, Point South is a logical tourist stop.

It is the Gateway from I-95 to the tourist destinations of historic Beaufort, the surrounding Sea Islands, the beaches of Hunting and Fripp Islands, Marine Corps Recruit Depot, Parris Island, and the Marine Corps Air Station Beaufort.



Frampton Plantation and the Lowcountry Visitors Center

The "Frampton House" property was part of an original King's Grant to the Frampton family in the 1700s. In 1865, General Sherman's troops burned the plantation house. In 1868, John Frampton rebuilt the present Lowcountry farmhouse and continued to work the land. Today, major renovations have taken place to prepare the "Frampton House" for a new life as the Lowcountry Visitor's Center and Museum. The Gift Shop offers unique souvenirs and distinctive gifts, including many South Carolina items.

American Revolutionary War Trail

Phase One of the trail runs through Jasper, Beaufort, Colleton, and Hampton counties. The trail retraces the footsteps of Dr. Uzal Johnson and the time he spent here with the New Jersey Volunteers during the spring of 1780. The highlights include the sites of skirmishes at Ft. Balfour, Saltketcher's Bridge, and McPherson's Plantation and the Battle of Coosawhatchie. The trailhead is located behind the Lowcountry Visitors Center in a gazebo designed to reflect the 18th century architecture and landscaping.
